

Board Meeting

April 6, 2026

Mayor Eilts called the meeting to order. Trustees Wittrig, Maness, Thornton, Nafziger, Springer, and Mohr were present.

Trustee Springer moved to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2026, meeting. Trustee Maness seconded the motion, and all Trustees unanimously approved the minutes.

Police Chief Price was here to present an opportunity to enter a ten-year contract with Axon Enterprises, Inc. This would include license plate readers, body cameras, and tasers, with all software, hardware, and upgrades. The total for ten years is \$110,000.02, with yearly payments beginning at \$11,000.00. Trustee Nafziger made a motion to enter a contract with Axon Enterprises, Inc., in the amount of \$110,000.02, paid over a ten-year period, in which 86% (\$9460.00) of the \$11,000.00 yearly payment will be paid out of TIF and the remaining \$1,540.00 would be paid out of the General Fund. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and with a "Roll Call" vote, the motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Springer had nothing to report on for Finance.

Trustee Thornton had nothing to report on Streets and Alleys.

Trustee Mohr had nothing to report on Building and Equipment.

Trustee Maness reported from the committee meeting held at the tennis courts at Railroad Park that he would move forward to obtaining pricing to convert 2 tennis courts for pickleball use and report back with his findings.

Trustee Wittrig moved to rent a boom to clean the Water Tower, with the rental not exceeding \$3,000.00. Trustee Springer seconded the motion, and with a “Roll Call” vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Springer moved to adjourn the meeting, and Trustee Mohr seconded the motion, and all Trustees voted “Aye.”
