

Board Meeting

July 6, 2026

Mayor Eilts called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Trustees Maness, Thornton, Mohr, and Nafziger were present. Trustees Wittrig and Springer were absent.

Trustee Thornton moved to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2026, meeting. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion, and it carried with all Trustees voting "Aye."

Under New Business, a motion by Trustee Maness and seconded by Trustee Mohr moved the Monday, July 20, 2026, Board meeting to Thursday, July 16, 2026, at 7:30 p.m. due to an expected lack of a quorum. A "Roll Call" vote passed unanimously.

Trustee Nafziger had nothing to report in Police and Health

With Trustee Springer absent, Trustee Thornton moved to reappoint Striegel Knobloch & Company LLC as our Village Auditor for this fiscal year ending April 30, 2026, with an annual contract rate of \$13,250.00. Trustee Mohr seconded the motion, and with a "Roll Call" vote, the motion passed.

With Trustee Wittrig absent, Trustee Maness moved to accept the Ordinance amending the municipal code regarding waste collection. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion, and with a "Roll Call" vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Thornton had nothing to report on Streets and Alleys. There will be a short committee meeting before the July 16th meeting regarding sidewalks.

Trustee Mohr moved to increase the amount to replace the bucket for the bucket truck from \$1,925.00, approved at a prior meeting, to \$2750.00. Trustee Maness seconded the motion, and it passed by a "Roll Call" vote.

Trustee Mohr moved to accept the 2026 lease agreement with Cross Implements for a new Gator for \$2,900.00. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and with a "Roll Call" vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Mohr moved to approve an ordinance authorizing the sale of the 2014 Chevrolet Tahoe for \$1500.00, as is. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and it carried by a "Roll Call" vote.

Trustee Mohr moved to purchase a 2023 Ford Super Duty F250 from Landmark Truck Sales in Springfield, Illinois, for \$51,366.63. The motion was seconded by Trustee Thornton and passed by a "Roll Call" vote.

Trustee Maness had nothing to report on Parks.

Trustee Mohr moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Maness seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, with all present Trustees voting "Aye". The meeting was adjourned.
