

Board Meeting

May 18, 2026

Mayor Eilts called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Trustees Maness, Thornton, and Nafziger were present. Trustees Springer, Wittrig, and Mohr were absent.

Trustee Thornton moved to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2026, meeting. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion, and all Trustees and Mayor Eilts

unanimously approved the minutes.

The Board recognized Amanda Palmgren from the 122 Stars Board. She was here to ask whether the 122 Stars could have a Food Truck in the Park on Saturday, June 13th. The organization is hosting a big tournament on Saturday and Sunday. Due to the Street Dance uptown on the 13th, Micki's is unable to cook for the event; Micki's will cook for Sunday, the 14th. The Board agreed to allow the Food Truck on Saturday, June 13th.

Under Old Business, Trustee Thornton moved to approve the closed session minutes from May 4th. The motion was seconded by Trustee Nafziger and passed with all Trustees present and Mayor Eilts voting "yes" on a roll call vote.

Trustee Maness moved to approve Appendix A from the closed session of the May 4th meeting. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and with all Trustees present and Mayor Eilts voting "yes" on a roll call vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Maness moved to purchase the online client portal from CUSI for \$4,240.00. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion. With all Trustees present and Mayor Eilts voting "yes" on the roll call vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Thornton had nothing to report on Streets and Alleys.

Trustee Mohr had nothing to report on Building and Equipment.

Trustee Maness had nothing to report on Parks.

Trustee Wittrig was absent, and there was nothing to report.

Trustee Nafziger had nothing to report on Police and Health.

Trustee Springer was absent. Trustee Maness moved to approve the May bills totaling \$87,0797.77, with \$30,425.41 from the General Fund, \$1,146.09 from the Street Lighting Fund, \$21,127.94 from the Liability Insurance Fund, \$53.85 for the Civil Defense Fund, \$5,553.15 from the Water Fund, \$2269.13 for the Sewer Fund, and \$26,504.20 from the TIF Fund. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion to approve the May bills. With all attending Trustees and Mayor Eilts voting “yes” on a roll call vote, the motion passed.

Trustee Maness moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, with all present Trustees and Mayor Eilts voting “Aye”. The meeting was adjourned.
