

Board Meeting

May 4, 2026

Mayor Eilts called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Trustees Maness, Thornton, Nafziger, Wittrig, and Mohr were present. Trustee Springer was absent.

Trustee Maness moved to approve the minutes of the April 20, 2026, meeting. Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and all Trustees unanimously approved the minutes.

Under Old Business, Trustee Maness moved to enter a contract for Village-wide trash service with Republic, with a July 1, 2026, start date (no recycling), pending 2-yard dumpsters one at the Village Hall, one at the City Park, and 2 carts at the Sewer Plant with weekly service. (Contract terms are to be negotiated and subject to final approval by the Village attorney and the Board.) Trustee Thornton seconded the motion, and with a "Roll Call" vote, the motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Thornton had nothing to report on Streets and Alleys.

Trustee Mohr had nothing to report on Building and Equipment.

Trustee Maness had nothing to report on Parks.

Upgrading the water billing system to the Customer Service Portal has been postponed until the Treasurer's reports are current. An estimate from A/B Hunter for televising has been deferred. Trustee Wittrig had nothing else to report regarding Water and Sewer.

Trustee Nafziger had nothing to report on Police and Health.

Trustee Springer was absent, and there was nothing to report on Finance.

Trustee Wittrig moved to close Main Street from 2nd Street to the Alley after the Bank for the June 13th Street Dance. Trustee Mohr seconded the motion, and with a “Roll Call” vote, the motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Mohr moved to close the regular meeting and to proceed to “Closed Session” for Employee Evaluations. Trustee Nafziger seconded the motion, and with a “Roll Call” vote, the motion passed unanimously. Closed session began at 8:30 P.M. with the following persons present in the Closed session: Trustees Maness, Thornton, Nafziger, Wittrig, and Mohr were present. Trustee Springer was absent.;

At 9:30 P.M., Trustee Mohr moved to return to Open Session. Seconded by Trustee Nafziger; Roll call vote. Motion passed unanimously. Board returned to Open Session at 9:31 P.M.

There being no further business, Motion by Trustee Mohr was made to adjourn; Trustee Nafziger seconded the Motion. All Trustees voted in favor, and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:35 P.M.
